Silifke-Tasucu Post-Secondary Vocational School , which was approved by Higher Education Committee (YÖK) in 1992, started education at same year with the only department of Tourism and Hotel Business with 73 students.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

Selcuk University Silifke-Tasucu Post-Secondary Vocational School is located on the South coast of Turkey in Silifke, Mersin.

It is far away 15 kms from Silifke and 100 kms from Mersin.

Minibus transportation to our school is available every five minutes from the surrounding places.

Moreover, buses come to Tasucu from every other parts of Turkey.

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GENERAL INFORMATION (cont.)

In the department of economics and administration programs there are 10 lecturers, 2 specialists and 24 instructors working as academicians. A two year pre-licence education is provided in the above mentioned three programs. The total duration of these programmes is 2 years.

The total duration of education in a year consists of two terms (called Autumn Term and Spring Term) the first of which starts in September and the second in February, both for at least 14 weeks. The total duration of the school education is 4 terms.

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TOURISM PROGRAMS

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TOURIST GUIDENESS

The students are educated first of all as tourist guides. They can do tourism organisations. They know the psychological situation of a tourist and they can behave in that way. With their excellent language knowledge, they can also organise tours properly. We accept our students with central exam essentially based on foreign language skills

We teach our students bearing in mind that tourism that is a permanent business sector requires modern and knowledgeable people to be effective.

Students get the chance to visit all the tourist sights in Turkey by going on a one-month training trip.

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TOURISM and HOTEL ADMINISTRATION

The objective of the two-year program in the Vocational School of Tourism and Hotel Administration is to prepare students for various junior management positions in hotels, restaurants and travel agencies.

We accept our students without central exam, coming from vocational high schools.

With the rapidly growing potential of tourism, as a leading industry in the economy, the need for well-trained middle management staff is obvious.

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TOURISM and HOTEL ADMINISTRATION (cont.)

Success in the hotel and restaurant industry requires substantial professional knowledge, business sense and human relations skills.

For this reason, the curriculum of the Vocational School of Tourism and Hotel Services aims at achieving "hands-on" experience.

The wide use of laboratories (e.g. training kitchen, restaurant etc.) provide the students with a firm background in professional skills.

Attention is also given to communication skills, foreign languages and computer applications.

A 60-day industrial training program at an establishment in the hotel or travel industry is compulsory. This takes place during the summer months after the successful completion of the first year.

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TOURISM and TRAVEL ADMINISTRATION

The students are equipped with a lot of modern knowledge about travel and transportation services bearing the needs of the sector in mind.

During the one month training, our students work in a variety of departments in a travel agency and become qualified tourism staff who can easily be promoted to administrative tasks.

We accept our students without central exam, coming from vocational high schools.
